This November, voters have the chance to make critical capital investments for New Jersey school districts and county colleges.

Why is this so important?

New Jersey's vocational programs are overflowing and there are not enough seats to meet demands.

The funds from this referendum will be used to build technical shops and labs at county vocational-technical schools and county colleges, and to invest in school security and water projects to keep students safe.

The "Securing Our Children's Future" public question seeks voter approval for:

- \$350 million for K-12 school security projects and expansion of career and technical education at county vocational-technical schools;
- \$50 million for county college career and technical education projects;
- \$100 million for school drinking water improvements, such as lead abatement.
